Premature ovarian failure (POF) is the loss of function of the ovaries before age 40. A commonly cited triad for the diagnosis is amenorrhea, hypergonadotropism, and hypoestrogenism. If it has a genetic cause, it may be called gonadal dysgenesis.. The term "primary ovarian insufficiency" was first used in 1942 by Fuller Albright who first described the condition.

Many patients are eager to begin maximal feminizing hormone therapy and are opposed to the idea of a slow upward titration. Weak evidence suggests that initiation of estrogen therapy at lower doses and titrating up over time may result in enhanced breast development in transgender women.

Depending on how early a baby is born, he or she may be: Late preterm, born between 34 and 36 completed weeks of pregnancy Moderately preterm, born between 32 and 34 weeks of pregnancy Very preterm, born at less than 32 weeks of pregnancy Extremely preterm, born at or before 25 weeks of pregnancy Most premature births occur in the late preterm stage.
